**Subject: ISIA inspection to ATUS courses and ISIA membership status**

Dear President,

We are glad to announce officially that, following the inspection process and the report of the commission that visited the courses organized by ATUS last March in Jahorina, the Technical Commission proposed to recognize ATUS with the ISIA Stamp status for their highest level courses.

The ISIA Praesidium ratified this last July, and officially announced the outcome of the inspection during the ISIA Assembly of Delegates, last September in Ushuaia.

Following this, it was proposed to the Assembly that ATUS became full member of ISIA: the Assembly of Delegates ratified the proposal, and then the status of ATUS in ISIA is now full member.

We are very glad to welcome ATUS as a new full member of ISIA: this means ATUS has now the right to issue the ISIA Stamp to their highest qualified teachers complying with the Minimum Standard requirements, and has the full membership rights and duties, as from the ISIA Constitution.

We take the chance to remind you, as from the Inspection rules, how to maintain and keep up to date over the time the status of your Association and the right to issue the ISIA Stamp:

**Renewal rules**

*Any change to the education system of an association must be promptly communicated to ISIA.*

*ISIA keeps the right of checking, on a random basis, the courses of the associated members.*

*In order to keep up to date, each association must attend at least 2 international ski events organized by ISIA or where ISIA is participating (f.i. the WC or Interski or ISIA technical events) every 5 years.*

*The Certification must be renewed when a substantial change in the courses or in the ISIA Minimum Standard happens. In such a case it must be confirmed by a new inspection from the Technical Commission, following the instructions above [Inspection rules].*

*Every Association should be inspected at least once every 10 years*

We wish the inspection execution and their outcome were of your satisfaction.
